politics as public art presents a keystone collection that pursues new frameworks for a critical understanding of the relationship between public art and protest movements through the utilization of socially engaged and choreopolitical approaches this anthology draws from a unique combination of interdisciplinary scholarship and activism where it integrates geographically rich perspectives from political and grassroots community contexts spanning the united states europe australia and southeastern africa the volume questions and reimagines not only how public art practice can be integral to politics including forms of surveillance and control of
